INITIAL CONSULT

1

This goes for around 1 hour and is the first piece of the puzzle. We'll deep dive into your concerns and discuss your medical, social and developmental history. From there, we'll discuss with you what assessments you'll need to complete and set goals that will guide future sessions.

ASSESSMENT SESSIONS

2

Based on your Initial Consult, your Speechie will tell you how many sessions it will take to complete assessments. These will look different for every person, and can be anything from following a set of instructions to play-based observations.

OUTCOMES

3

We'll give you the info you need to take action and explain it in a way you can understand. Again, this will look different for every client. We can also provide a detailed formal assessment report for a fee to help unlock more support via funding or professional assistance.
